

LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1973

DIRECTION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY COMMISSION FOR SCOTLAND 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following direction, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 15(3) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 and all other powers enabling them to do so.

The Scottish Ministers direct the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland not to undertake a review of any local government area under the terms of section 14(1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 during the period beginning on 1 April 2012 and ending on 31 March 2017.
