**(Bearsden and Milngavie, Stirling and Strathkelvin Districts)**  
**Boundaries Order 1977**

*Made* - - - - 5th January 1977

*Laid before Parliament* 17th January 1977

*Coming into Operation* 1st April 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 17(2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) to give effect to proposals made by the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland under section 14(2) of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

*Title and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Central and Strathclyde Regions (Bearsden and Milngavie, Stirling and Strathkelvin Districts) Boundaries Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1977.

*Interpretation*

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Application of Regulations*

3. The Local Government Area Changes (Scotland) Regulations 1977(c) shall apply for the purposes of this order to such extent as may be required to implement the area changes effected by article 4 of this order.

*Area changes*

4.—(1) Those parts of the Stirling District and the Central Region situated at Mugdock, described (firstly) and (secondly) at Part 1 of the Schedule to this order, and delineated and shown cross-hatched on the map annexed and signed as relative to this order, shall be transferred to the Bearsden and Milngavie District and the Strathclyde Region.

(2) That part of the Stirling District and the Central Region situated at Craigmaddie Loch, described at Part 2 of the said Schedule and delineated and shown hatched horizontally on the said map shall be transferred to the Strathkelvin District and the Strathclyde Region.

(3) That part of the Strathkelvin District and the Strathclyde Region situated at Craigash Farm, described at Part 3 of the said Schedule and delineated and shown hatched vertically on the said map shall be transferred to Bearsden and Milngavie District and the Strathclyde Region.

## SCHEDULE

*Article 4*

### TRANSFERRED AREAS

#### PART 1

The areas transferred by article 4(1) of this order are bounded as follows:

(firstly) commencing at NG ref NS 55247637 on the Central Region Boundary thence generally northeastwards and southeastwards along the field boundary to a point where it meets the regional boundary at NG ref NS 55457650; thence along the existing regional boundary southwards and westwards to the point of commencement and

(secondly) commencing on the existing boundary of the Central Region and the Stirling District at NG ref NS 55547645 and the western boundary of the embankment of Mugdock Road; thence northwestwards along the said boundary to a point on the western boundary of Mugdock Road; thence eastwards in a straight line crossing the said road to the southern end of the footpath leading from Mugdock village; thence generally southeastwards following the adjacent field boundary and the northern boundary of the water works property to the point where the said boundary meets the existing regional boundary at NG ref NS 56077628; thence following the existing regional boundary generally westwards to the point of commencement; and the new portions of the boundaries between the Stirling District and the Central Region and the Bearsden and Milngavie District and the Strathclyde Region are delineated on the map annexed and signed as relative to this order.

#### PART 2

The area transferred by article 4(2) of this order is bounded as follows:

commencing on the existing southern boundary of the Central Region and the Stirling District at NG ref NS 57147697; thence generally southwards and south-eastwards along the said regional boundary to the western boundary of the A81 road; thence generally northwestwards along the said western boundary to NG ref NS 56927680; being a point in prolongation of the western boundary of the parcel containing Craigmaddie Loch; thence in a straight line northeastwards to and along the western and northwestern boundaries of the said parcel to the point of commencement;

and the new portions of the boundaries between the Stirling District and the Central Region and the Strathkelvin District and the Strathclyde Region are delineated on the said map.

#### PART 3

The area transferred by article 4(3) of this order is bounded as follows:

commencing at the point where the existing northern boundary of the Strathclyde Region meets the western boundary of the A81 road; thence generally southwestwards along the said western boundary to a point where it meets the western boundary of the Strathkelvin District; thence generally northwestwards following the said district boundary to the point where it meets the northern boundary of the Strathclyde Region; thence following the existing regional boundary generally northeastwards and southeastwards to the point of commencement; and the portions of the boundaries between the Strathkelvin District and the Bearsden and Milngavie District are delineated on the said map.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order transfers (a) the Mugdock Reservoir and associated areas of land from the Stirling District and the Central Region to the Bearsden and Milngavie District and the Strathclyde Region; (b) an area in the vicinity of Craigmaddie Loch from the Stirling District and the Central Region to the Strathkelvin District and the Strathclyde Region; and (c) within the Strathclyde Region an area in the vicinity of Craigash Farm from the Strathkelvin District to the Bearsden and Milngavie District.

A copy of the map referred to in Article 4 may be inspected at the offices of any of the local authorities referred to in this Order.
