CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS
The Caithness and Sutherland Districts (Tongue and Farr)
Boundaries Order 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 17(2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) to give effect with modifications to proposals made by the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland following a direction given under section 15(2) of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Caithness and Sutherland Districts (Tongue and Farr) Boundaries Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1977.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Application of Regulations

3. The Local Government Area Changes (Scotland) Regulations 1977(c) shall apply for the purposes of this order to such extent as may be required to implement the area change effected by article 4 of this order.

Area change

4. The area comprising the parishes of Tongue and Farr in the Caithness District shall be transferred to the Sutherland District, the boundaries of the said area being delineated and the area hatched on the map annexed and signed as relative to this order.
