CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Hamilton and Motherwell Districts (Strathclyde Park)  
Boundaries Order 1977

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	5th January 1977
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	17th January 1977
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st April 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 17(2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) to give effect to proposals made by the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland under section 14(2) of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

*Title and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Hamilton and Motherwell Districts (Strathclyde Park) Boundaries Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1977.

*Interpretation*

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Application of Regulations*

3. The Local Government Area Changes (Scotland) Regulations 1977(c) shall apply for the purposes of this order to such extent as may be required to implement the area change effected by article 4 of this order.

*Area change*

4. The area comprising that part of the Hamilton District described in the Schedule to this order and delineated and hatched on the map annexed and signed as relative to this order, shall be transferred to the Motherwell District.

SCHEDULE

TRANSFERRED AREA

The area transferred by this order is bounded on the north and east by the existing boundary between the Hamilton District and the Motherwell District and on the south west by the centre of the channel for the time being of the River Clyde as altered between Bothwell Bridge and Clyde Bridge.
