**The Cumnock and Doon Valley and Kyle and Carrick
Districts (Dalrymple) Boundaries Order 1977**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 17(2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) to give effect to proposals made by the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland following a direction given under section 15(2) of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Cumnock and Doon Valley and Kyle and Carrick Districts (Dalrymple) Boundaries Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1977.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Application of Regulations

3. The Local Government Area Changes (Scotland) Regulations 1977(c) shall apply for the purposes of this order to such extent as may be required to implement the area change effected by article 4 of this order.

Area change

4. The area comprising that part of the Cumnock and Doon Valley District situated north and west of the village of Dalrymple, described in the Schedule to this order and delineated and shown hatched on map 1 annexed and signed as relative to this order, shall be transferred to the Kyle and Carrick District.

SCHEDULE

Article 4

TRANSFERRED AREA

The area transferred by this order is bounded as follows:—

commencing at the point where the existing Kyle and Carrick District boundary crosses the A713 road; thence generally southeastwards along the western boundary of the said road to its junction with the B742 road; thence generally southwestwards along the western boundary of the last named road to Dustyhall Bridge; thence generally southwestwards along the centre line of the Purclewan Burn to its confluence with the River Doon on the existing Kyle and Carrick District boundary; thence following the existing district boundary generally southwestwards, northwards and northeastwards to the point of commencement; and the new portion of the boundary between the Cumnock and Doon Valley District and the Kyle and Carrick District is delineated on map 2 annexed and signed as relative to this order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the order.)

This order transfers from the Cumnock and Doon Valley District to the Kyle and Carrick District an area of approximately 1,797 acres lying to the north and west of the village of Dalrymple.
