CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Monklands and Strathkelvin Districts (Gartcosh Steel Works and Whitehill, Gartcosh) Boundaries Amendment Order 1984

Made - - - - - 6th December 1984
Laid before Parliament 7th January 1985
Coming into Operation 1st April 1985

Whereas under section 17(1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland on 4th July 1983 submitted to me a report on a review conducted under section 14(2) of that Act in which they made proposals for the transfer of certain areas from Monklands District to Strathkelvin District and in which they also made proposals for changes in electoral arrangements consequential on those changes in local government areas;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 17(2) of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Monklands and Strathkelvin Districts (Gartcosh Steel Works and Whitehill, Gartcosh) Boundaries Amendment Order 1984, and shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

Interpretation

2. In the Schedule to this order—
- (a) any reference to a boundary of a district is a reference to a boundary existing immediately before the commencement of this order; and
 - (b) any reference to a burn shall, where the context so admits, be construed as a reference to the centre line thereof.

Application of regulations

3. The Local Government Area Changes (Scotland) Regulations 1977(a) shall apply for the purposes of this order to such extent as may be required to implement the area changes effected by article 4 of this order.

Area changes

4. Those parts of Monklands District containing areas at Gartcosh Steel Works and Whitehill, Gartcosh described in the Schedule to this order and delineated and hatched on the map signed as relative to this order shall be transferred to Strathkelvin District.

Consequential changes of electoral arrangements

5. The areas described in the Schedule to this order (being the areas transferred by article 4 of this order)—

- (a) shall form part of Electoral Division 48 (Chryston and Kelvin Valley) of Strathclyde Region(b) and of District Ward 12 (Chryston) of Strathkelvin District(c), and
- (b) shall cease to form part of Electoral Division 52 (Coatbridge North) of Strathclyde Region and of District Ward 3 (North Central and Glenboig) of Monklands District(d).

AREA A

Commencing on the western boundary of Monklands District at a point where the boundary crosses the Bothlin Burn; then southeastward in a straight line to a point on Glenboig Road at the northeast corner of parcel No. 5520 as shown on 1:2500 scale Ordnance Survey microfilm NS 7168 Edition BB date of publication 1974; then southeastward, generally southward and southeastward along the eastern boundary of the said parcel and continuing southeastward along the southern boundary of parcel No. 3200 as shown on 1:2500 scale Ordnance Survey microfilm NS 7167 Edition C date of publication 1970 to the western boundary of parcel No. 4200; then southeastward and northeastward along the western and southern boundaries of the said parcel and continuing northeastward along the southern boundary of parcel No. 5300 to the northeastern boundary of parcel No. 4090; then southeastward along the said northeastern boundary to the Cumbernauld-Glasgow railway line; then southwestward along the said railway line to the Bothlin Burn; then generally southwestward along the said Burn to the western boundary of Monklands District; then northward along the said district boundary to the point of commencement.

AREA B

Commencing on the western boundary of Monklands District at NG ref. NS69946741 being a point in prolongation southwestward of the track south of the property known as Whitehill; then northwestward, northeastward and southeastward along the western boundary of Monklands District to and southwestward and northwestward along the track leading southwestward from Kingshill Cottages to Coatbridge Road; then northward along Coatbridge Road to and westward and southwestward along the track south of the property known as Whitehill and in prolongation thereto to the point of commencement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order transfers an area of approximately 43.5 acres (Area A of the Schedule) at Gartcosh Steel Works and an area of 22.2 acres (Area B of the Schedule) at Whitehill, Gartcosh from Monklands District to Strathkelvin District. The order also makes consequential changes of electoral arrangements.

The areas transferred are shown on the map which forms part of this Note.

Copies of the map referred to in article 4 of this order may be inspected at the offices of any of the local authorities referred to in this order.
