CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Nairn and Inverness Districts (Croy) Boundaries Amendment **Order 1984**

Made -20th December 1984 Laid before Parliament 16th January 1985 Coming into Operation 1st April 1985

Whereas under section 17(1) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland on 30th January 1984 submitted to me a report on a review conducted under section 14(2) of that Act in which they made proposals for the transfer of a certain area from Nairn District to Inverness District, and in which they also made proposals for changes in electoral arrangements consequential on that change in local government areas;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 17(2) of the said Act, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Nairn and Inverness Districts (Croy) Boundaries Amendment Order 1984, and shall come into operation on 1st April 1985.

Interpretation

2. In the Schedule to this order any reference to a boundary of a district is a reference to a boundary existing immediately before the commencement of this order.

Application of regulations

3. The Local Government Area Changes (Scotland) Regulations 1977(b)

shall apply for the purposes of this order to such extent as may be required to implement the area change effected by article 4 of this order.

Area change

4. That part of Nairn District containing an area at Croy described in the Schedule to this order and delineated and hatched on the map signed as relative to this order shall be transferred to Inverness District.

Consequential changes of electoral arrangements

- 5. The area described in the Schedule to this order (being the area transferred by article 4 of this order)—
 - (a) shall form part of Electoral Division 40 (Strathdearn, Strathnairn and Loch Ness East) of Highland Region(a) and of District Ward 19 (Strathdearn/Strathnairn) of Inverness District(b); and
 - (b) shall cease to form part of Electoral Division 47 (Nairn County) of Highland Region and of District Ward 8 (North Nairnshire) of Nairn District(c).

Commencing on the western boundary of Nairn District at its junction with the northern side of the B9091 road west of the War Memorial; then northeastward along the northern side of the said road to and northwestward and southwestward along the eastern and northern perimeters of Croy Public Hall and Rifle Club building and continuing southwestward along the northern boundary of the area of land north of the Memorial to the western boundary of Nairn District; then southeastward along the said District boundary to the point of commencement.


EXPLANATORY NOTE
