I write in relation to the ongoing boundary review of Cardowan/Stepps and comment in favour of the proposal to change the area to North Lanarkshire Council.

There is a current precedence set due to previous changes in the neighbouring area of Jackson Drive and the Honeywell estate. The Dunlop residents should be no different to the neighbouring areas that have changed as the same rationale should apply. Dunlop residents local North Lanarkshire Council services i.e libraries, GP services and are currently at a disadvantage from neighbours who fall under the North Lanarkshire boundary.

The Dunlop residents are also currently at a disadvantage in terms of schooling. It is unfair to expect children to travel to the current school catchment area, which is 5 miles from the Dunlop Estate and has lack of transition facilities within the catchment for children. The children would also be attending school outwith the area that they have developed friendships with and have involvement in events in the wider community. The current transport arrangements to the catchment school 5 miles away would be 2 buses and walk to the school, taking approximately an hour and half each way. This is not feasible and shows why the children are at a severe disadvantage to that of their neighbours in the area.
