2. Our nearest retail access points are in Stepps and Muirhead
3. Our "local" library is in Stepps
4. While schooling is not a specific issue for us, the closest "local" schools are in Stepps and Chryston and it seems crazy that parents have to send children further afield with schools on their doorstep
