Dear Sir/Madam

I am writing to you in order to offer my reasoning for supporting the boundary change for the area East of Dewar Road from Glasgow City Council to North Lanarkshire Council.

My main reasons are as follows

The estate adjacent to the one in question was approved and it therefore makes sense for this development not to be changed also.

It isn't economical or ecological to send lorries to collect our refuse from Glasgow as it is further out than the other parts of the boundary.

Currently my child will need to attend a school some distance away from her home and her friends who live only around the corner. Funding for a separate bus to collect children to take them to a GCC school is once again not economical or ecological.

There is also huge confusion amongst health care services in the area (health visitors, doctors etc) which has negatively impacted on the care and wellbeing of my daughter. Both councils are uncertain if they are to provide after birth care for my area due to the boundary. This has meant having to make unnecessary journeys to a surgery which neither me or my daughter attend, in order to receive care from a health visitor. My daughter and I are registered in a North Lanarkshire surgery due to it being the closest, surely our Council boundary should be the same.
