Hello

I am emailing as part of the consultation into boundary change for postcode G33 6GY from Glasgow city council to North Lanarkshire. I am in favour of a move of boundary to North Lanarkshire.

I am a new mother and my pre-natal and midwifery care was all provided by North Lanarkshire. These were local and very easy to access. The breast feeding team support being available locally is the reason i have been able to breast feed. Birthing classes have linked me with other parents giving me additional support.

My health visitor care has been from Glasgow city council. Although my health visitor has been great I have found it more difficult to access other support such as breast feeding classes as they are held in easterhouse. It also means I am less connected with other new mums locally leaving me more isolated.

Moving to North Lanarkshire would help new mums to access local services and provide contact with other mums. I can only imagine this is the same for other health issues. Leaving us in Glasgow means we are more isolated and disadvantaged compared with our direct neighbours
