First of all expectant mothers are expected to travel further afield for regular midwifery appointments pre and post baby.
Our children are unable to access books and educational activity with peers from the library within our area.
Our children face being at a massive disadvantage when it comes to schooling by travelling further to schools and being separated from their home community.
Our preschoolers are expected to join nurseries outwith the community.
We pay a higher rate of council tax than our neighbours.
There is a major sense of isolation from other communities in our area and an inability to create a community within our development as a whole.
Not only are we expected to travel a further distance for schools but also for polling stations.
