The boundary issue really affects my life, my 2 children are refused to schools in the North Lanarkshire council - these schools are within walking distance from my house and are much more easy to commute to as I work full time, however the boundary issue means I need to place placement requests to get into these schools which I state again are in walking distance. We drive on North Lanarkshire roads every day, and we pay £1,000 more on council tax compared to our neighbors who live in the North Lanarkshire council region.
